

## **Important Bird Areas Program**

### **Bird Blitz 2009: New Germany State Park**

Another 2009 Bird Blitz target area for western Maryland was the New Germany State Park candidate IBA, including all land owned and managed by the Maryland Department of Natural Resources as the State Park. This site is located amid the Savage River State Forest in northeastern Garrett County and encompasses approximately 400 acres of forested habitat. The majority of the park's coniferous and mixed forest was surveyed in 2009 while participants made use of existing park trails and roads. One volunteer and one Audubon staff member conducted 3 surveys covering 7.2 km of transects during 3.8 survey hours (Table 1).

The results of these surveys are summarized below in Table 2, with highlighted species representing those with count totals that exceeded their state-level IBA thresholds. Remember that Bird Blitz survey totals represent minimum population estimates of breeding pairs. Actual populations are higher because not all available habitat was covered and because some birds along a route may not be counted (if they were silent and/or hidden while observers passed by). Three at-risk species were recorded, including 1 Louisiana Waterthrush, 1 Canada Warbler, and a count of 13 Blackburnian Warbler which exceeded its state-level IBA threshold of 10 pairs.
